Distemper, and Rabies are administered every 3 years after initial puppy series. Wellness Exam, Lepto, Lyme, Bordetella, Heartworm Check, and Intestinal Parasite Check are yearly.

Lepto, Lyme, and Bordetella are recommended based on your pets level of exposure. Ask our staff if your pet is at risk.

Puppies 6 months of age or older must be heartworm tested before starting heartworm preventative for the first time.

Feline Distemper vaccine (fvrpc) is administered every 3 years after initial kitten series. Wellness exam, FelV, Feline Rabies and intestinal parasite checks are yearly.

FelV is recommended based on your pets level of exposure. Please ask our staff if your pet is at risk.
